
Q. Miguel, 2022 Boeing Classic champion. How does it feel?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: It feels great. I did not play very good all through the year, but today yeah. But it's been close to coming. But I'm happy, and I'm hitting the ball all the week very solid. Two bogeys on the first nine hole of the tournament, and then the last 45 holes is birdie-free round. And I make 14 birdies in the last 45 holes.

Q. Yeah, birdies on 11 and 12. Then a great par save on 13. Is that where you got the --

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: On 13?

Q. Over the bunker, 13.

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: Yeah, yeah, on the 13. That is that par 3.

Q. Uh-huh.

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: Yeah, yeah. I make a nice shot, a little bit too much draw on the pitch on the top and go to the bunker. I make a very good approach. Not very good putt. Very good approach. Other than that, and then I save the par. The approach is very important. That's the only shot I missed in two and a half rounds. That was a miss and -- it's nice to recover, you know. It was solid, solid.

Q. What is the key to getting around this course so well?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: Well, the key is to be hitting good. And I feel confident with my game. I feel good from the tee and feel good with every club from the bag. And I played very solid. Very, very solid.

I make par (indiscernible) today, and I feel like I miss some opportunities there. Yesterday from the past, also some more opportunities on there. And it's -- not much to say, really. I feel very solid from green to tees and consistent.

Q. How will you celebrate? Is it good food, good wine, good cigar?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: Good cigar, of course. Good wine, good cigar, good -- everything good, you know. The life is too short to have bad things.

Q. That's true.

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: You have to have the good things.

Q. Big trophy.

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: Yeah.
