Things to Know

- Charles Schwab No. 4 **Miguel Angel Jimenez** and 2015 Boeing Classic champion **Billy Andrade** share the lead at 10-under entering the final round.
- **Joe Durant** posted the round of the day with 9-under 63 to move from T48 to T6 on the leaderboard.

Miguel Angel Jimenez, 70-64 – 134 (-10)

- Matched his low 18-hole score of the season (48th round)
 - R2/U.S. Senior Open, R3/Shaw Charity Classic
- Looks to become the third three-time winner this season on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Would join Steven Alker (3) and Jerry Kelly (3)
 - Won the Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai and Cologuard Classic
 - Would be Jimenez's first three-win season on the Champions Tour
 - Has won at least once in each of his eight seasons, including two-win seasons in 2018, 2019, 2020-21 and 2022
- This is his 17th time leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Is 6-for-16 converting those into victories
- Is playing in the last group of the final round for the fourth time this season
 - Is 1-for-3 converting those into victories
- 58-year-old seeks his 13th win on PGA TOUR Champions (130th start)
- Has finished in the top 10 in each of his three appearances at the Boeing Classic
 - Best finish: T3 (2018)
 - Today's round is his lowest 18-hole score at the Boeing Classic (11th round)
 - Has broken par in all 11 rounds at the Boeing Classic

Billy Andrade, 68-66 – 134 (-10)

- Matched his low 18-hole score of the season (40th round)
 - R3/ClubCorp Classic

- With a win on Sunday, the 2015 champion would become the third multi-time winner of the Boeing Classic
 - Would join Bernhard Langer (2010, 2016) and Tom Kite (2006, 2008)
- 58-year-old seeks his fourth win on PGA TOUR Champions (188th start)
 - All three of his previous wins came in 2015
- With a win on Sunday, he would snap a winless streak of 6 years, 9 months, 6 days (or 2,471 days), dating back to the 2015 Charles Schwab Cup Championship
- Making his 14th start of the season, his best finish is 5th (ClubCorp Classic)
- 2022 Payne Stewart Award recipient is playing in the last group of the final round for the first time this season

Other Notes

- Three players are T3 at 8-under, including first-round co-leader **K.J. Choi**, Charles Schwab No. 6 **Stephen Ames** and **Gene Sauers**, who carded 8-under 64 on Saturday.
- Charles Schwab Cup leader **Steven Alker** is T6 at 7-under, along with Senior Open champion **Darren Clarke**, **David McKenzie** and **Joe Durant**.
- Seeking his fourth win in his last seven starts this season, 2017 Boeing Classic champion **Jerry Kelly** sits T12 at 5-under.
- Seattle native **Fred Couples** carded 1-under 71 and sits T16 at 4-under.
