Q. Sixty-seven today, that's a pretty good score. Pretty happy with it?

JIM FURYK: Yeah. I got off to a good start, birdies at 1 and 4 and then 8 and 9 kind of -- it was the opposite yesterday. I was 1 over through seven yesterday and 8, got it to even and had a good back nine, shot 4 under there. Kind of flipped it today, but good solid back nine as well, just didn't see a couple putts go in. Really just felt like I was happy with yesterday, I feel like today's round was a little bit more solid, maybe a little bit better ball-striking.

Q. How confident are you heading into tomorrow?

JIM FURYK: Yeah, my game's been in decent shape. I've had a lot of time off. I kind of got -- for the three weeks off, I got away from golf, felt like I was a bit rusty but was able to play a bunch of practice rounds this week. I played a practice round on Tuesday, the pro-am on Wednesday and Thursday, so got a lot of rounds under my belt. I've been feeling a little bit more comfortable every day with my game, so hopefully that keeps going tomorrow.

Q. Any idea what you might need to shot tomorrow to win?

JIM FURYK: It's going to depend on the weather, the setup. I don't think the wind's supposed to blow that much. We'll see. A lot of it's -- I thought the pin placements were a little tougher today, scores weren't quite as good today and I think that's more on the pin placements, maybe not quite as accessible. We'll see a little bit of the golf course setup and how the wind is, but just kind of keep doing what I'm doing and it should be close.
