## Things to Know

- Miguel Angel Jimenez posted bogey-free 67 on Sunday to win the Boeing Classic by two strokes over David McKenzie.
- Jimenez earned his third win of the season, tied for the most on PGA TOUR Champions in 2022, and moved to No. 3 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings.
- Brett Quigley carded the round of the day with 8-under 64 to move from T43 to T8.

## Miguel Angel Jimenez, 70-64-67 - 201 (-15)

- Played the final 45 holes without a bogey, beginning on Hole No. 10 of Friday's first round
- 58-year-old earned his 13th win on PGA TOUR Champions (130th start)
  - Moved to T20 on the Champions Tour All-Time Wins List
  - Moved to T3 among active players (chart below)
- Becomes the third three-time winner this season on PGA TOUR Champions, joining Steven Alker (3) and Jerry Kelly (3)
  - Also won the Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai and Cologuard Classic
  - Jimenez, Alker and Kelly are the only three multi-time winners this season, and have combined to win nine of the 17 tournaments in 2022
  - o It is Jimenez's first three-win season on PGA TOUR Champions (chart below)
    - Has won at least once in all eight seasons on PGA TOUR Champions
- Improved to 7-for-17 when leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions
- Improved to 2-for-4 when playing in the last group of the final round this season on PGA TOUR Champions
- Has finished in the top 10 in each of his four appearances at the Boeing Classic
  - Has broken par in all 12 rounds, with a scoring average of 67.92 at this event
- Earned the 14th victory by a player from Spain on PGA TOUR Champions
- Earned his 10th top-10 this season (16 starts)
- Moves to No. 3 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings

#### **Other Notes**

- Third-alternate **David McKenzie** closed with bogey-free 66 to finish second at 13-under, matching his best finish on PGA TOUR Champions (2nd/2019 SAS Championship). With his finish, he earns a spot into next week's DICK'S Sporting Goods Open.
- Overnight co-leader and 2015 Boeing Classic champion Billy Andrade and Charles Schwab No. 6 Stephen Ames finished T3 at 11-under.
- Charles Schwab Cup leader Steven Alker finished fifth at 10-under for his 11th top-5 this season (14 starts).
- Seeking his fourth win in his last seven starts this season, 2017 Boeing Classic champion Jerry Kelly finished sixth at 9-under.
- Defending champion **Rod Pampling** closed with 4-under 68 to finish T8.
- Seattle native **Fred Couples** closed with 2-over 74 to finish T28.
- Cameron Beckman withdrew during the final round.
